## *Loretta Kelley, Hardanger Fiddle*

Loretta Kelley is the foremost American performer on the hardingfele (the traditional Hardanger fiddle), an intricately decorated fiddle native to Norway with sympathetic strings, a nearly flat bridge, and a 300-year unbroken aural tradition. Loretta specializes in sl tt music, dance tunes rooted in the 18th century with sometimes unique asymmetrical rhythms, modal scales with "floating" intervals, and haunting tonalities.

An inspiring teacher and brilliant dance musician, Loretta is a key figure in the hardanger fiddle revival in this country. She has taught at innumerable workshops, music and dance camps and privately. Her performances include appearances on *Prairie Home Companion*, *All Things Considered*, and *The Christmas Revels*. One of her four recordings a collaboration with Charlie Pilzer and Andrea Hoag, "Hambo in the Snow" was nominated for a 2007 GRAMMY Award as Best Traditional World Music Album.
